Frequently Asked Questions

How large is the building and when was it built?

The building size is 19,868 square feet – two full floors plus a small mechanical area. Its original Grand Opening was in May, 1960. Over the years it housed the *Daily Tribune* and WFHR 1320AM / WWRW 103.3FM radio stations.

Who built it?

William F. Huffman, former owner and publisher of the *Daily Tribune*, built the building; he believed in the role of informed and active citizens in a democratic government, which aligns with Incourage's vision of a connected, engaged community.

What was the purchase price?

Incourage purchased the building, assessed at \$668,000, for \$527,000 and is committed to securing resources for the adaptive reuse of the property.

How do I get involved?

Join us on Tuesday, October 8. Spread the word! RSVP online, phone or email.

Who can participate?

Everyone living in the south Wood County area may participate in sharing ideas and making decisions. This is an exciting opportunity for all community members to help design a unique space.

What is the process?

Simply share your ideas on October 8. A facilitator will help participants express their ideas through small groups discussions, writing on post-it notes, etc. Whatever your style of expressing ideas, we'll make it comfortable and fun. This is the first meeting of four.
