**PHASE 3, MEETING 1: JANUARY 27
MEETING SUMMARY**

SUMMARY

What happened at the January 27 Tribune meeting?

On January 27, 2015, participants learned from and shared with each other, personal interests and experience in a number of Tribune-related areas: arts, cafe/brewpub, community and downtown development, creative workshop, culinary kitchen, microbrewery, recreation, and youth. This was the first opportunity for residents to focus on one program area that excited them. Residents enjoyed building new relationships and sharing their experience and ideas to help inform the future programming within the building. Of the 125 residents in attendance, approximately 25 participants were new to the Tribune Building Project process. New participants brought a fresh perspective to the work and their participation was welcomed and valued.

Within interest areas, residents shared their enthusiasm for the Tribune and identified community assets that align with and compliment the Tribune's program areas. Some examples include:

- Goods from local farmers and food systems that could be used in the Culinary Kitchen and Cafe/Brewpub spaces
- Access to bike paths and trails that can be utilized by residents when renting equipment from the Recreational Rentals space
- Opportunities for local home brewers within the Microbrewery space
- Identification of complementary art facilities within the community
- Integration of downtown events with Tribune activities

What will happen at the next meeting?

Meeting 2, to be held on March 10th, will focus on continued relationship building, networking, and interest area work. Residents will also receive important Tribune Building and Incurage updates.
