<p><u>Scene Setter 4</u> Your brother insists you took his favorite CD.</p>	<p><u>Response A</u> "Mom! He's picking on me."</p>	<p><u>Response B</u> "You jerk! Why would I want one of your lame CDs?"</p>	<p><u>Response C</u> "No, I did not take your CD, but I will help you look for it."</p>
<p><u>Scene Setter 5</u> A student is wandering around the lunchroom looking for a seat.</p>	<p><u>Response A</u> "Who said you could sit here?"</p>	<p><u>Response B</u> Ignore-keep talking to your friends.</p>	<p><u>Response C</u> Say hello, be welcoming.</p>
