Hello, potential Tribune window artists!



Incourage is looking for artists in our community who are interested in being part of an art project called *Friday Night Lights at the Tribune Building* (220 1st Ave S, Wis. Rapids). Here's what we have planned:

What will artists do?

Artists will paint their original designs on the inside of the windows in the Tribune Building's

circular portion of the Tribune. Windows measure 4 feet by 6 feet. We would like artists to create their design around the theme of **Community Assets**, be it nature, place, people, etc. Be creative! Residents will view your creation from **outside** the building, so if you use words, they will need to be painted backwards for readability.

What happens then?

Each Friday from August through October, we'll turn on the building's lights at dusk to let the artwork shine forth through the night!

What Incourage provides:

- Paint brushes (If you have your own favorites, please bring them.)
- Different colors of acrylic paint mixed with Elmer's glue
- Windows 6 foot x 4 foot

What you can bring:

- Ladder or step stool
- A creative design for our **Community Assets** theme

We did a test painting on a window, so you can see how it will look at night with the light shining from within the building. The test image to the left is in the front left corner of the Tribune's riverside round section. We'll start by painting the first floor's six windows. When they're filled, we'll work on filling the second floor.
