UTILIZING change to make a change...

Learning how to save for the future is very important, but not always an exciting topic. Miss Wisconsin Rapids, Maria Hartley, rose to the challenge and figured out how to make it fun and impactful. Your unrestricted gifts to Incourage made a \$1,000 grant possible to support costs for Making a Change, where during May almost 3,000 students from area schools each received a piggy bank and group learning sessions led by Maria on personal financial literacy, including ways to assist others. Students learned that every penny can help make their own future more stable and can then lead to helping others as well. Students had the option of passing along some of their saved up change to help others in the community. Together

they gathered \$3,380.61 to support FOCUS's community food security efforts.

Lifelong learning enriches lives. Through the generosity of many donors who have chosen to pay it forward in support of generations to come, incourage manages 110 scholarships funds, with each reflecting the unique criteria

awarded 172 scholarships amounting to \$194,000 in furtherance of their continued education. Scholarships ranged from \$500 single-year awards, to \$5,000 awards covering multiple years, with an average award being \$1,128. Since inception in 1994, donor generosity has resulted in Incourage awarding 4,220 scholarships totaling \$3.2 million, all starting with a single \$500 scholarship awarded that initial year. Many of the scholarships honor a loved one or someone important in the donors' life, and often encourage pursuing a specific passion and/or career. Most fundraising events end up needing similar physical items to make them happen. Established by the Heart of Wisconsin Leadership Program Class of 2014, with start up funding from Incourage, the Community

Fundraising Resource Center was created to gather and house common items used for local fundraising events. When over 50 agencies gathered in 2014, they concluded it would be more cost effective for them to donate and share items they generally need for fundraisers (i.e. grills, freezers, tents, games, etc.), rather than each having to rent or buy them every time. The Center is still supporting local nonprofit events, but realized a gap was having reusable typical signage for directing folks to things like restrooms, vendors, volunteers, tickets and raffles. A \$1,000 grant from incourage unrestricted funds made it possible for the purchase of long lasting signage to share.

PARTNERING with donors and organizations for a stronger community...

Beyond 110 scholarship funds, Incourage also manages 278 additional funds for a variety of charitable purposes. Each is a reflection of the generosity and passions of donors like you, who have chosen to support a wide variety of philanthropic community efforts, programs and organizations. Each fund benefits from the economies of scale achieved when charitable assets are pooled together for administrative and investment purposes. This is one of the many benefits of giving through a community foundation, to strengthen the philanthropic community.

In the first half of 2023, 134 grants amounting to \$527,082 were awarded to 60 non-profit organizations. ENGAGING youth in pursuit of their passion...

The Central Wisconsin Symphony Orchestra (CWSO) has been enriching, engaging and educating our community through the power and performance of live music for the past 75 years. In May of this year, CWSO agreed to take over the Youth Symphony Program and its staff, which had previously been a program at the University of WI - Stevens Point since 2014. CWSO reached

out to Incourage and others for start up funding to ensure continued access to this valued community program. Through a combination of Incourage unrestricted funds and suggestions from three donor advised funds, grants totaling \$3,250 were made possible. The Central Wisconsin Youth Symphony Orchestra Program (CWYSOP) will continue to provide local access to quality music education and performance opportunities. CWYSOP enriches the lives of youth who have the desire to explore expressing themselves musically as a fulfilling hobby and/or a possible career path.
