#### **December 31, 2023, Investment Performance**

For the period of January 1 through December 31, 2023, Incourage's endowed portfolio realized a gain of 17.2% after fees, ahead of our peers' median returns.

As of December 31, the endowed portfolio three-, five-, ten- and twenty-year annualized rates of return were gains of 5.1%, 9.7%, 6.7% and 6.6% after fees, respectively.

## **Feature Story**

### Promoting Healing Through Public Art

Our young people are facing many challenges today, which may cause some to have behavioral issues that lead them down the path of becoming a part of the youth justice system. Helping area youth to engage in healthy and respectful interactions, to take responsibility for their actions, and to have their voices empowered is an important element of helping them to address challenging situations they have encountered from decisions they have made.

Wood County Human Services is partnering with Rise Up Central Wisconsin to lead the Youth Restoration Project, a participatory public art mural to promote healing within local youth justice participants. Your unrestricted gifts to Incourage made a \$2,000 grant possible to support the costs associated with this initiative.

Youth ages 11-18 from the Wood County Youth Mentor Program, the Adolescent Diversion Program, 4-Sight,

and Youth Justice, were invited to participate. The mural project supports the well-being and development of young community members by expanding Rise Up's mission of bringing people together and transforming not only a piece of art, but ourselves, and our community.



Installation Process

The project aims to improve health outcomes for individuals

by building stronger alliances and connections between service providers, youth, and the community, reducing stigma surrounding loneliness, and leaving a more resilient community in its wake. The project offers the potential to attract visitors to our community, much like murals in Stevens Point and Wausau do. While the mural site is not yet confirmed, the ideal location will be in a very visible, high traffic location in the Wisconsin Rapids community.
